BW-44 works with all black and white films. The stock solutions have a long shelf life; the working solution has high capacity, and is suitable for large or small format. BW-44 gives sharp highlights and shadow detail.

MIXING THE WORKING SOLUTIONS

This kit contains 2 bottles of Stock Solution labeled A & B.

To make the working solution, mix the two stock solutions and water in the ratio of 1:1:5.

For example, to make 1000 ml of working solution:

143 ml Stock Solution A 143 ml Stock Solution B 714 ml Water (68° F)

The following table will give you recommended times for various film types.

Temperature at 20° C/68° F, with 5 inversions every 30 seconds:

Film type	Dilution	Time
T-MAX 100	1:1:5	6.5 minutes
TRI X	1:1:5	6 minutes
Ilford HP 5	1:1:5	5.5 minutes
Ilford FP 4	1:1:5	7 minutes

BW-44 can be used up to a 1:1:20 dilution, with no change in fog level, shadow detail or film speed.

Our Excel Film Enhancer (catalog no. 05-1000) works very well with BW-44, giving crisp, easy-to-print negatives. We especially like to shoot copy negatives with BW-44/Excel. Using 1000 ml of BW-44 with 30 ml of Excel added, with Ilford Pan F, we are developing for 5.5 minutes at 68° F, at a 1:1:10 dilution.

As with any developer you are unfamiliar with be sure to test your film before developing any valuable shots!

LIFE OF THE WORKING SOLUTION

This solution is only good for one working session once A & B have been mixed; therefore only mix what you need.

The Stock Solutions have a life of 1 year if kept in a tightly sealed bottle, out of direct light.
