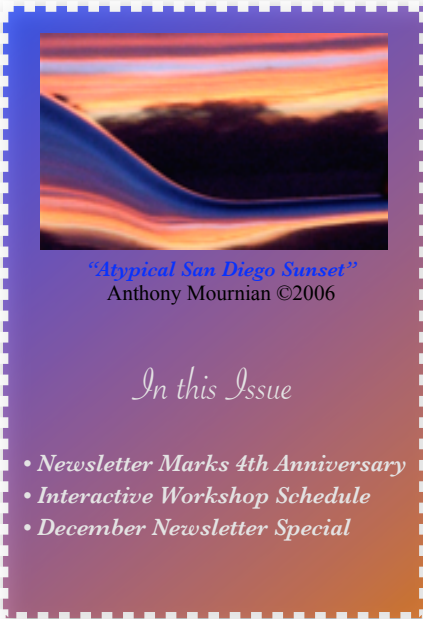

Remember, with **Acrobat Reader** you can always enlarge the size of the type in the document. Open the PDF. Go to the *Menu Bar* at the top of your computer screen and look for the small rectangle with **100%** inside it. Click on the rectangle and you will see your choices of different sizes. Pick the size you want, and the PDF is instantly enlarged for easier reading.

Along the way we've made some changes in the appearance of the newsletter, and more recently in the content, by adding videos. Our goal has always been to bring you articles of interest, about other photographers and their work, and about the Alternative Processes we offer in our summer workshops.

We've also tried to bring you Monthly Specials with real value to you, the working photographers and practitioners of the Alternative Photographic Processes.

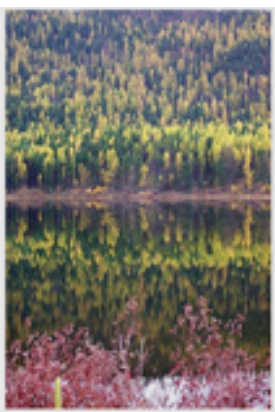
